Parents who are applying for their child to enter our Specialised Learning Program: Autism Spectrum Disorder (SLP ASD) at Eaton Community College will need to follow the timeline below to be sent an Expression of Interest application package.

SLP ASD Expression of Interest application package forwarded to the family as places become available.	Directed by SLP ASD Program Coordinator
If the application is successful - fill out a formal ECC enrolment application	TBA

Documents required with your application include:

- Most recent school report
- Most recent NAPLAN report
- Most recent OLN report (if applicable)
- Diagnostic reports confirming Autism diagnosis – confirmation from a paediatrician after triage with Speech Pathologist and Clinical Psychologist
- Signed Permission to Release and/or Exchange Information Form
